Dr. Caspi is is a tenured senior investigator, Section Head and Chief of the Laboratory of Immunology, National Eye Institute, NIH. She also holds an Adjunct Professorship at the University of Pennsylvannia Sch. Med. Dr. Caspi's research centers on responses to immunologically privileged retinal antigens in animal models of autoimmune uveitis, a potentially blinding human disease. Her recent work emphasizes the role of the gut microbiome in this process. Dr. Caspi's work studies have elucidated many basic mechanisms and helped devise clinically relevant immunotherapeutic approaches.
