

The 2014 winner of the Dolph O. Adams award is Ilhem Messaoudi. Dr. Messaoudi is an associate professor in the Division of Biomedical Sciences within the University of California Riverside. She received her B.Sc. in Biochemistry from Lafayette College in 1996. She then obtained a joint doctorate degree in immunology from The Weill Graduate School of Medical Sciences of Cornell University and Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in 2001 before obtaining a post-doctoral fellowship at Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) and Oregon National Primate Research Center (ONPRC). Dr. Messaoudi became an assistant professor at OHSU/ONPRC in October 2008 before moving to Riverside to join the new School of Medicine at UCR in January 2013.
